Her recent work is a response to liber naturae (the Book of Nature), an idea tracing back to generations of philosophers who considered the natural world a source of limitless text to be studied as a symbolic repository of divine wisdom. Richard currently lives in Gainesville, Florida where she works in her studio and teaches.
